## Spy Tariff shared inputs on Sirsa airbase with Pak officials, say cops

GURUGRAM, MAY 26

A local Nuh-based quick, who was arrested on the charge of spying for Pakistan, has admitted to having shared information about the Sirsa airbase with Pakistani officials. During his seven days' police remand, the police recovered Pakistani currency and mobile phones from his house. Tariff was produced in a Nuh court and sent to judicial custody.

The Haryana Police and Central investigative agencies claim that during remand, Tariff revealed many secrets. During interrogation, he also admitted to having information related to international activities with high officials of Pakistan.

During probe, Tariff admitted to sharing photographs and videos of the Sirsa airbase with

Asif Baloch and Zafar, employees at the Pakistan High Commission, Delhi, through WhatsApp. Two thousand Pakistani currency notes, two mobile phones and other documents were recovered from his house. One of the mobile phones is registered in his name while the other was registered in his wife Afzama's name. Evidences related to chats, etc. shared from Tariff's mobile phone with Pakistani numbers also recovered from mobile phones, said an investigating officer.

After the completion of the remand period, the accused was produced in the court, which sent him to judicial custody.

On the other hand, Afzama said she could not believe that Tariff could do this. She said he had gone to Pakistan with his family three and he never betrayed the country and their family.

## Two held for theft at grocery store

GURUGRAM, MAY 26

While cracking a case regarding theft at a grocery store in Pundhana, the Nuh police have arrested two persons and recovered some stolen cash and silver items from their possession.

Nearly Rs 3.40 lakh cash and around 300-gm silver were stolen. An FIR was registered in the case. The accused were identified as Tariff and Wasim Akram. "Rs 47,540 in cash, four silver coins and a silver biscuit were recovered from them," said an official. —TNS

## Monsoon woes: Stormwater to come up in G'gram's Narsinghpur

GMDA to lay 750-m pipeline to channelise stormwater to

Following a month-long dedicated effort, the Gurugram administration has finally managed to find out a solution to the waterlogging problem in Narsinghpur, Gurugram. Lying along the NH-48, this area witnesses worst waterlogging after every spell of rain, thus crippling mobility. With a long-term drain construction stuck in litigation, a team led by DC Ajay Kumar has managed to work out a temporary stormwater drain.

"The long-term permanent solution to Narsinghpur is still awaited owing to litigations, but we will ensure there will be no waterlogging here during the monsoon season any more. We will be constructing an open drain to get the water put along the gravity. Prior to this, we were pumping water against gravity, which made efforts futile. The drain will be built by the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) and we have managed to secure space for the same. We are making the area encroachment-free," said DC Ajay Kumar while speaking to The Tribune.

The absence of an outlet

for stormwater drain makes Narsinghpur, the lowest point on Delhi-Gurugram Expressway, the worst waterlogging point in Gurugram. Rainwater from the Aravallis and new sectors developed along Southern Peripheral Road (SPR) accumulates at this point, but there is no outlet. Only way to drain the area is through pumps.

As part of the new plan, a major joint demolition drive was conducted by the

GMDA and Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (HSIIDC) to clear the encroachments in the Narsinghpur and Mohammedpur areas, situated along NH-48, to further facilitate the laying of drainage infrastructure to resolve the recurrent issue of waterlogging at the Narsinghpur service road during the monsoon season.
