The Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has launched a systematic waste along railway tracks across the national capital, with the authorities aiming to clear thousands of metric tonnes of garbage within the next 10 days.

According to officials, around 123 km of railway tracks run through Delhi and several stretches pass alongside slum clusters and JJ colonies, where waste dumping has led to a major sanitation challenge. The civic body estimates that over 15,000 metric tonnes (MT) of waste had accumulated along the railway corridors over time. So far, the MCD has already cleared around 5,000 MT of waste as part of the ongoing campaign.

Explaining the scale of the problem and the strategy being adopted, MCD Commissioner Sanjeev Khirwar said the civic body had prepared a detailed plan to address the issue in a systematic manner.

"Considering the long stretch of tracks along with safety and security concerns of its personnel, the MCD has prepared a comprehensive plan to remove this legacy waste from the railway tracks," said Sanjeev.

The civic body is also working to ensure that such waste accumulation does not recur in future by putting in place a structured cleaning system.

"The MCD is putting in place a regular cleaning mechanism

so that separate interventions at different intervals are not required in future. For systemic improvement, the MCD is also inviting special tenders to engage concessionaire for zone-wise regular cleaning of railway track," the MCD Commissioner said.

To carry out the ongoing drive, the MCD has mobilised significant manpower and machinery. At present, 145 vehicles, including trucks, auto tippers, Hyvas and JCB machines, along with nearly 800 sanitation workers, have been deployed across different zones of the city.

However, there are some challenges in carrying out the operation. Since railway tracks witness heavy train movement, sanitation teams require permission and temporary operational blocks from the Railways before beginning work along certain stretches.

Officials said several portions of the tracks are also located in inaccessible areas where municipal vehicles cannot reach easily. To tackle this issue, the MCD has sought logistical support and coordination from the Railway authorities.

Joint coordination teams between the MCD and the Railways are currently working at the zonal level to ensure uninterrupted waste removal and smooth execution of the drive.

According to the DCP, the comments were made in his personal capacity and were not representative of the department's functioning. Taking cognisance of the matter, the Delhi Police removed him from the charge of the SHO with immediate effect and transferred him to District Lines.

MOSCOW: Russian air defence units have destroyed 28 Ukrainian drones heading to attack the capital on Sunday...

AS IRAN THREATENS TO WIDEN WAR Gulf Arab states intercept new missiles and drones

CAIRO: Gulf Arab states reported new missile and drone attacks on Sunday after Iran threatened to widen its campaign and called for the evacuation of three major ports in the United Arab Emirates as the war in the Middle East, now in its third week, expands further.

Israel and the United States attacked Iran on Feb 28, saying they were striking nuclear and military sites and encouraging the Iranian people to rise against their leaders.

The war has spread global air travel, disrupted oil exports from the region and sent fuel prices rising.

US President Donald Trump said he hoped countries reliant on oil and gas exports would send warships to secure the Strait of Hormuz.

Iran had earlier accused the US of launching Friday's strikes on Kharg Island from the UAE, without providing evidence for the claim.

Iran has fired hundreds of missiles and drones at the UAE, Bahrain, Saudi Arabia, Qatar and Oman during the war. It says it targets US assets, even as Iranian strikes are reported at civilian sites such as airports and oil fields.

Iran's foreign minister, Abbas Araghchi, said the US attacked Kharg and Abu Musa islands from locations in the UAE. He called the escalation dangerous and said Iran 'will try to be careful not to attack any populated area' there.

Anwar Gargash, a diplomatic adviser to the UAE president, rejected Iran's claim that the US used Emirati land or airspace for its attacks on Kharg Island.

Araghchi also told the London-based Al-Araby al-Jadeed on Sunday that Iran is ready to consider any proposal that includes 'a complete end' to the war and said mediation efforts were ongoing between Iran and its neighbours to de-escalate.

He gave no indication of whether progress has been made. As global anxiety soars over oil prices and supplies, Trump said Saturday he hopes China, France, Japan, South Korea, the United Kingdom and others send warships to keep the Strait of Hormuz 'open and safe.'

CAIRO: At least 12 Palestinians, including two boys, a pregnant woman and eight police officers, were killed Sunday by Israeli airstrikes in the war-torn Gaza Strip, hospital authorities said.

A strike Sunday morning hit a house in the urban refuge camp of Nuseirat in central Gaza and killed four people, including a couple in their 30s and their 10-year son, according to the nearby Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital. The woman had been pregnant with twins, the hospital said.

The fourth fatality, a 15-year-old neighbour, was taken to the Awda hospital in Nuseirat. 'We were sleeping and got up to the strike of a missile. The strike was strong,' said Mahmoud al-Multaqa, a neighbour. 'There was no prior warning.'

Pakistan launched Operation Ghazab ul-Haq on Feb 26 in response to alleged attacks by the Afghan Taliban forces at 53 locations along the 2,600 km-long border. In a social media post, Information Minister Attaullah Tarar confirmed the military action in Kandahar and shared its footage.
